The purpose of the NCFE Level 3 Diploma in Management Skills and Knowledge is to provide the knowledge, understanding and skills required to work as a team leader/supervisor.

The qualification consists of 9 mandatory units:

Leading people, Communication, Managing people, Building relationships, Operational management, Project management, Managing finance, Self-awareness and continuous development, Decision making.

The objectives of this qualification are to help learners to:

- focus on the study of management within different occupational areas
- demonstrate the skills, knowledge and behaviours they will need to operate as a successful team leader/supervisor
- develop skills and knowledge in a range of areas relevant to their role, such as leading and managing people, building relationships and communication, operational and project management, finance and personal effectiveness

L3 DIPLOMA IN MANAGEMENT SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE

What are the entry requirements?

There are no specific recommended prior learning requirements for the above qualification. However, learners may find it helpful if they've already achieved a Level 2 health and social care related qualification.

How are they assessed?

Learners must successfully demonstrate their achievement of all learning outcomes of the units as detailed in the qualification specification and is internally assessed.

Eligibility

- Anyone living in a West Midlands Combined Authority postcode - see link <https://skillspostcodecheck.com/tool/>
- Lived in UK for 3 years or more
- Over 19 on 1st August
- Employed and receiving regular shifts (for full L3 Diploma in care)
- Can be unemployed
- Fully funded if they earn £36k or less, 50% funded otherwise
- Open to all care employers / learners, or for employers that approach us directly 'stand-alone'
- Also Suitable for Step into Care learners that wish to progress to L3 after completing L2 Diploma in Adult Care
- Good levels of literacy to complete assignments (level 2 – approx. gcse A-C) determined by a free writing exercise / assessment
